Dream Landscape™

Ever see a beautiful scene that you *know* would make an amazing quilt? In this workshop you will learn how to capture and translate your favorite landscape photographs into colorful designs and unique fabric art.

You'll create your own dream landscape while learning and using Fast-Pieced Appliqué™ techniques and embellishments. In our time together you'll learn the secret of how this technique uses machine piecing and appliqué in combination to simplify complicated curves and circles, capture the spirit of your photos in fabric form, and new skills and techniques to apply in future projects.

SUPPLIES:

- Photos, or drawings that you would like to develop a design from
- (2) black & white copies of the items above
- Digital camera (optional)
- Pencil/Eraser, Fine line (not ultra-fine) permanent black marker
- Tracing Paper 9x12 or 11x14 paper**
- Tracing Paper large 18"x24" (or roll 18" wide or wider)**
- Freezer Paper 18" wide**
- Multi-Plug Extension cord with surge protection**
- Table-top light**
- Permanent glue stick**
- A range of cotton or silk fabrics, small-medium-large scale, light-medium-darks, batiks work as well. Let the photos you plan to use be a guide to colors selection and remember it is better to have more choices if possible. (If silks selected please iron on a lightweight interfacing before class)**
- Larger pieces of fabrics for quilt backs coordinating with top fabrics
- Batting – Minimally, crib size ready to use. (Light weight- Hobbs/Heirloom, Warm& Natural)**
- Sewing machine in good working condition with zigzag capability and an appropriate foot for zigzag stitching**
- Bernina users should bring #21 foot if you have one, others may bring couching or cording feet if desired.**
- Variety of yarns for couching
- Basic sewing supplies (include Sewer's Aid liquid for decorative threads)
- Basic sewing thread, Decorative thread and clear monofilament thread
- Masking Tape and Several safety pins for basting
- Duck-Bill Appliqué, sewing and paper scissors
- Cutting board, ruler and rotary cutter
- Iron with auto shut off feature and ironing board-if driving
- Sheet to cover your work at night

FOR EMBELLISHING:

- Fabric scraps that will work with the piece to be embellished
- Batting scraps (light weight- Hobbs/Heirloom, Warm& Natural)**
- Embroidery Floss of various colors**
- Superior Bottom Line Polyester or silk-wrapped cotton thread matching fabrics in quilt for beading
- Light weight heat & bond**
- #11 Sharps & #12 / Crewels for hand sewing
- Beads/ Buttons/ Bangles/ any other objects you would like to see 'on top'
