# Capture and Create – *Gabriella Goodness and her Angelic Friends*

This is a new class taking things just a few steps further than “Geraldine.” It’s big, and is a challenge, but you will learn at least:

- How to take an image of an animal and create a whimsical quilt.
- Raw edge appliqué with attitude.
- A small sample of Kantha background quilting. (hand)
- A sample of line, negative space quilting.
- You will create and quilt your own crow. Yes, a crow from my pattern.
- You will learn the magic of “Pam’s Houses”

You will use my pattern of the Giraffe, the crows and, of course, the houses... but its BIG.

### REQUIREMENTS

- 1-1/2 yards of bright plain fabric for the background of your animal, or my Giraffe, known as Gabriella Goodness. (I used yellow)
  - Kaffe Fassett fabric that you can cut the flowers or images out of to create Giraffe spots.
  - 1 yard black and white spot fabric for the mane.
  - 1 yard of black fabric for the 3 crows.
  - 12” square of bright yellow for their beaks.
  - 12” square of white fabric for the legs.
  - 2 yards of plain fabric for the background of the quilt. I used red cherry wood fabric.
  - 2 yards of checked fabric for the border. I used Kaffe Fassett.
- I will give instructions on how to complete the top of the quilt before we add the appliqué prior to class if you wish.
- 1 reel of black 50-weight Aurifil thread.
  - A few spare bobbins filled with the same thread.
  - An open toe free motion foot.
  - The normal feet for your machine (for assembling the top and for quilting)
  - 4 yards of Steam-A-Seam Lite fusible web. You will need a lot and it needs to be Steam-A Seam because we will assemble the appliqué prior to quilting.
  - Backing and batting (cotton), masking tape for taping, and safety pins for making the sandwich. Please, no basting spray.
  - A .5 black pigment ink pen to draw the small houses.
  - A package each of ‘sharp’ embroidery machine needles. 70/10 and 80/12. (Not Universal, Sharps.)
  - A packet of hand stitching needles to work with Kantha thread. (large eye)
  - I will be bringing a variety of Aurifil Kantha threads for you to buy.
  - Aurifil thread (50 weight cotton) for the quilting of the quilt background.
  - If driving, bring a multi-plug extension cord with surge protection.
  - Table top light.
  - Something to cover your work at night.
