SUPPLY LIST

- 40" X 20" piece of non-patterned background fabric
- 40" X 20" piece of fabric for the back of the quilt
- 40" X 20" piece of thin cotton batting
- 1 - 10" square of black fabric
- 3 - 10" squares of medium small patterned fabric
- 4 - 10" squares of turquoise and blue small patterned fabric
- 5 - 10" squares of red and orange small patterned fabric
- 1 Fat quarter of fabric for highlight (I used the purple and red spot Kaffe fabric)
- ½ yard of good quality white fabric
- Basting spray or safety pins to baste the quilt
- A portable light box, if possible
- Kaffe Fassett fabric works well in this pattern
Please do not wash your fabric
- 1 yard square of fusible web (*Wonder Under* or *Steam-A-Seam*)
- 1 spool of 50 weight black thread (*Auriful* or *Masterpiece* by Superior)
- 1 pkt of 70/10 *Schmetz* Microtex needles
- Open-toe free motion embroidery foot for your machine
- Walking foot for your machine
- I will have .5 black pigment ink pens for sale at \$5.00 and a black Tsukineko pen for sale.
- Table-top light
- Multi-plug extension cord with surge protection (If driving)
- Something to cover your work at night

Requirements for Your Own Design

- 1 yard square of non-patterned background fabric
- 1 yard square for the back of the quilt
- 1 yard square of thin cotton batting
- A variety of small patterned fabrics, once again, Kaffe fabrics work well.
- 1 yard square of fusible web (wonder under or steam a seam)
- 4 large sheets of thick tracing paper (vellum) and 1 pencil
