Karolyn “Nubin” Jensen Pickled Clams using Floating Edge Appliqué

SUPPLY LIST

This is a very scrappy happy quilt. There are 52 printed clams and 52 solid clams. All the Prickles on the clams are out of solid fabric.

PRINTED CLAMS

I used 30+ different printed fabrics in my quilt. I pulled fat quarters that I loved and had fun! My motto on this one is “the more the merrier”. Each clam takes about a 6”x8” piece of fabric. If you want it less scrappy...total yardage for printed fabric is about 2 yards

SOLID CLAMS AND POINTS for paper pieced sections

- 14 different 1/3 yard cuts of solid fabric

This is to be used for the 52 solid clams and ALL the points in the paper pieced section

You can get 4 solid clams and enough points for 8 blocks from the 1/3 yard cut

- Background fabric for paper pieced points — 3.5 yards of a solid fabric for your background
- Binding on the top of each clam (*I used the same fabric for the binding and piping*) — 1.5 yards
- Piping on each clam (*I used the same fabric for the binding and piping*) — 1.25 yards
- Inner Border — 1/2 yard
- Outer Border — 2 yards
- Binding for quilt — 3/4 yards
- Backing — 4 yards
- One sheet of clear template plastic
- Piping Hot Piping tool by Susan K. Cleveland
- Thread to match your piping and clam shell background
- Thread for your paper piecing
- Rotary Cutter and mat
- 24”x 6” (or 6.5”) ruler for cutting strips
- Good fabric scissors
- Good paper scissors
- Tracing pen/chalk/pencil to trace the clam shells onto your fabric
- Sewing machine in good working order, with manual
 - 1/4” foot (with a guide is very helpful...Bernina’s #57 foot)
 - Appliqué foot (Bernina’s #23 foot is wonderful for this technique)
 - A zipper foot will work if you don’t have an appliqué foot
- Table top light

KIT FOR CLASS

This will include the pattern, preprinted paper pieced sections (you will need to decide if you want regular paper...that you tear away after you sew... or my dissolving paper, that washes away), cotton cording for the piping, glue and glue tip.
