

Build a House and Create a Story

Build a raw-edge wool house, fused and appliquéd to your chosen background: wool, flannel, or cotton. Patterns for different style houses will be provided: English Cottage, French Chateau or Traditional American Home. Make it your own with embellishments. Bring those collected treasures, perle cotton, embroidery thread, silk ribbon, ribbon, trims, lace, buttons, beads, charms and found objects. Demonstrations of many embroidery stitches, silk ribbon stitches, couching and attaching found objects. Hand sewing and embroidery.

SUPPLY LIST

Patterns for an English Cottage, French Manor, Craftsman and Victorian styles will be provided. We will be working on a piece about 20 by 20 inches. Patterns for windows, doors and added objects will be included to make your piece unique.

Fabrics:

- Wool, good quality flannel, or cotton for your background. At least a fat quarter.
- Wool in a variety of colors, some larger pieces and scraps are ok for details.
- Black tulle

Threads:

- Perle cotton. I use mostly size 8 and 12. Plain colors and variegated, which adds interest.
- Wool thread e.i. Elezanza.
- Stranded embroidery thread.
- Regular sewing thread to match your wool.
- Any unusual thread or yarn for details.

Ribbon:

- Silk ribbon in 2 mm and 4 mm. Optional but bring it if you have it.
- Decorative ribbon

Lace:

- Lace under 1 inch wide.

Buttons:

- Small for doorknobs etc

Beads:

- Accent beads, optional

Charms:

- For accent

Found objects:

- This can be something personal. A rock from a beach walk. Anything that speaks to you but isn't to large.

Needles:

- Embroidery sharps with a large eye
- Chenille and tapestry needles. For silk ribbon and perle cotton.

Miscellaneous:

- Reference books for embroidery stitches and ideas, I'll bring mine.
- Marking pens for light and dark fabric
- Ruler
- Rotary cutter
- Scissors, paper and fabric
- Light for your table
- Cover for workspace
- Class fee of \$20.00 covers fusible web, I use Flexi-fuse as it is easy to sew through.

I will bring small wool scraps, lace trims, small buttons, ribbon and whatever else I can find to share.
