SUPPLY LIST

- 14"X10" Water Fabric
- 14"X10" Reef Fabric (this will be covered up with embellishments)
- 14"x20" thin batting
- 14"x20" backing fabric
- 4 3"x20" fabric strips for facing
- Sewing machine with zigzag capabilities
- General sewing supplies
- Threads
- Hand sewing needles
- Any extra embellishments, trims, etc. you might want to include
- Kit** – includes precut and pre-fused applique sea life, shells, buttons, beads, fun fabric scraps, doodads, trims, glues, mixed media and the tools for different techniques. Kit fee is \$50.00 paid to teacher at class.
- If driving, bring a multi-plug extension cord with surge protection
- Table top light
- Something to cover your work at night
