Building Quilts Using Architectural Elements

Using framented architectural elements, learn the power of line, and how scale creates depth and ambiguity in an art quilt. Using imagery of architectual elements on cloth, fusing and layered cloth construction will be taught. Emphasis will be learning how to start a series. This is a student-driven workshop, with students defining their long- and short-term goals for the workshop. Sign up early because there is prep time needed for fabric preparation. I have been working on an architectural series for more than ten years and have about 70 quilts in the series. I have learned a lot and would like to share this knowledge with you.
