

MATERIAL MATRIX

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Supply List for “Frank”

Finished size: 26” by 30”

- Sewing machine, *in good working order*, including a 1/4” foot
- Rotary cutter and mat (sharp blades, please)
- Ruler for cutting (ie: Omnigrid), best size-2-1/2” by 12-1/2”
- Thread, 50 weight, a couple of colors to go with your fabric choices
- Sewing kit with the usual tools: scissors, pins, seam ripper, etc.
- Pens or pencils for marking on *both* light and dark fabrics
- A stack of sticky notes (ie: Post-Its, light colors best)
- A piece of cardboard 9” by 14” •Fabric (see below)
- The photo printed out, that is here with the supply list
- Tabletop light and extension cord, power strip with surge protector, if driving.
- Something to cover your work at night

FABRIC: You will collect fabric by using the photo provided here with the supply list as a visual guide. Go for variety, and you will need mostly dark aquas/greens and oranges/pinks. As you are collecting, go through your stash first. Bring scraps, 1/8ths yards, 1/4 yards and even larger amounts that have nice ombre effects in the colors you need. You may use batiks, prints, solids, even stripes and polka-dots, they all can work (but I suggest using solids in moderation). Jelly rolls are OK but you will not be able to use them in every situation. **Please do not cut any fabric ahead of time.** There’s a good photo of my finished quilt on my website you can use for reference.

Print out the photo that is provided with this supply list for your reference in picking fabric.

It should fit nicely on 8-1/2” by 11” paper.

There is a \$5. class fee for handouts and a tool I will give you.
